Weather Emergency Policy**






IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Supreme Court Administrative Order 1998-5, that the 33rd District Court will not close for weather emergencies unless ordered to do so by the Chief Judge. The decision to close the Court will be based on whether citizens and employees can safely reach the Court and/or return home given the weather conditions. Notification that the Court will close will be made by making telephone calls to employees, police departments, and city halls, as well as posting signs on the doors and broadcasting public service announcements on radio and television, if possible.

The 33rd District Court does not share a facility with any of its funding units. There is no consistency among the funding units regarding paying employees in the event their facility closes due to weather. The Court Management Council unanimously agreed that the decision whether to pay court employees in the event the Court closes due to weather will be left to the discretion of the Chief Judge regardless of whether any funding units close or any funding unit employees are paid for the hours their facility closes.
